Ministry in China, Myanmar,
Nepal & the Philippines

This ministry is the platform from which we hope to bring high impact to Third World nations, in particular, China, Myanmar, Nepal and the Philippines. The objective is to do substantive works such as church buildings (legacy stuff), Homes for the Aged, Orphanages, Schools and of course, Church-Planting. The Lord showed me whilst I was traveling in ministry that this is a golden opportunity for us to build for His Kingdom in the Third World where it takes a lot less to do what it takes in the developed world. Now is time for building legacy - so that generations to come in these countries will be able to point out structures and works saying those from "Singapore &/or Australia did this and that for us. They have empowered and positioned us for the future".

To this end, our first step commences with Nepal - where I just returned from speaking to a combined churches camp of some 500 adults. It was great time, matter of fact a time in season, with Ps JN (missionary from Singapore) and Ps Narayan Pradhan (NP).

Ps NP - Banepa Rophecca AG Church

This awesome pastor - a man of integrity with a church of over 400 people now; working with Ps JN for the last 9 years (and in particular the last 6 years where he collaborated closely in building the New Life Missions Centre for the training of local pastors and leaders) and now together planted or help planted some 51 churches in various part of Nepal.....I visited one and was truly impressed. Preached and prayed for people who flooded the altar in response to the Word - simple village people but you can see the hand of God.

I felt the Lord wants the new ministry to see NP through his building project (3 storey but in common with many other buildings in Nepal, raw cement, unpainted, no aesthetic but functional - even in winter time (which is really cold!). To enable significant completion, we are looking at S\$50,000 to S\$60,000.

I have visited NP's church 3 times in 4 four years - and it is still the shack; with due respect smelly, earth for floor and zinc for roof complete with granite stones and wooden pillars to hold it down! I just felt that we, blessed out of our socks, need to do a lasting legacy work here - build something substantive for the Nepalese....

New Life Missions Centre (School of Ministry)

Ps JN is a major driver of this wonderful school - just graduated their 11 batch of students many of whom ended up planting churches.

JN needs S\$200,000 for the project but he has already raised plenty - the Lord providing "mighty men" around him! He only asked that the new ministry raise S\$10,000 for him and he will seek help elsewhere.....I believe this is very doable.....to see a great school up and continue training and church-planting in one of the world's poorest economies! (If we wait for indigenous self-sufficiency, we will have to wait till Jesus come - seriously.)
