Matter of fact, personal pronouns are used throughout the Bible to describe and identify with the Holy Spirit. He has personal title and performs personal acts. Holy Spirit is indeed God. [Read Acts 5].

The Holy Spirit is imperative to our Christian life. John 14:15 says that the Holy Spirit is defined as one “standing alongside” us.

The Greek word used here, “*paraclete*” translates as advocate, counselor, comforter and helper. What can we do without the Holy Spirit?

Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Christian conversion and baptism of the Holy Spirit are two separate events.

One event follows the other. This doctrine implies the initial evident of speaking in tongues. It is a physical manifestation of the overflowing indwelling Holy Spirit. Jesus said, “streams of living water will flow from within him.” John 7:38-39

The indwelling Holy Spirit within the human spirit produces an inner invincibility; a boldness quite unknown to human kind.

Spiritual Gifting

Spiritual gifting is from God. It is assigned sovereignly by Him. We cannot demand it; it is as God moves.

Spiritual gifts are received not achieved.

good. However, gifts can easily become ends in themselves. They can glorify the user rather than the giver. Spiritual gifts do not reflect spiritual maturity.
